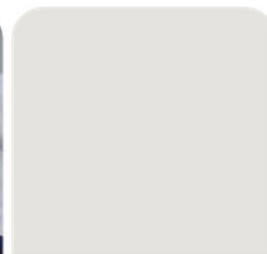
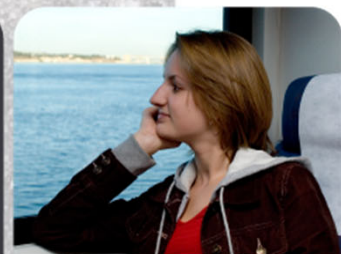

# PROJECT HISTORY

- **December 11, 1991:** Passenger rail service to Roseville opens
  - Since the opening Placer County's goal has been to grow train service
- **1998:** Capitol Corridor Business Plan includes 4 round trips to Auburn/10 to Roseville
- **2002-2011:** Continuous coordination with UPRR to initiate further studies for increased train service
- **2014-2015:** The CEQA process is initiated resulting in the preparation of an Environmental Impact Report (EIR)
- **November 18, 2015:** Project EIR is certified

## Project Objectives

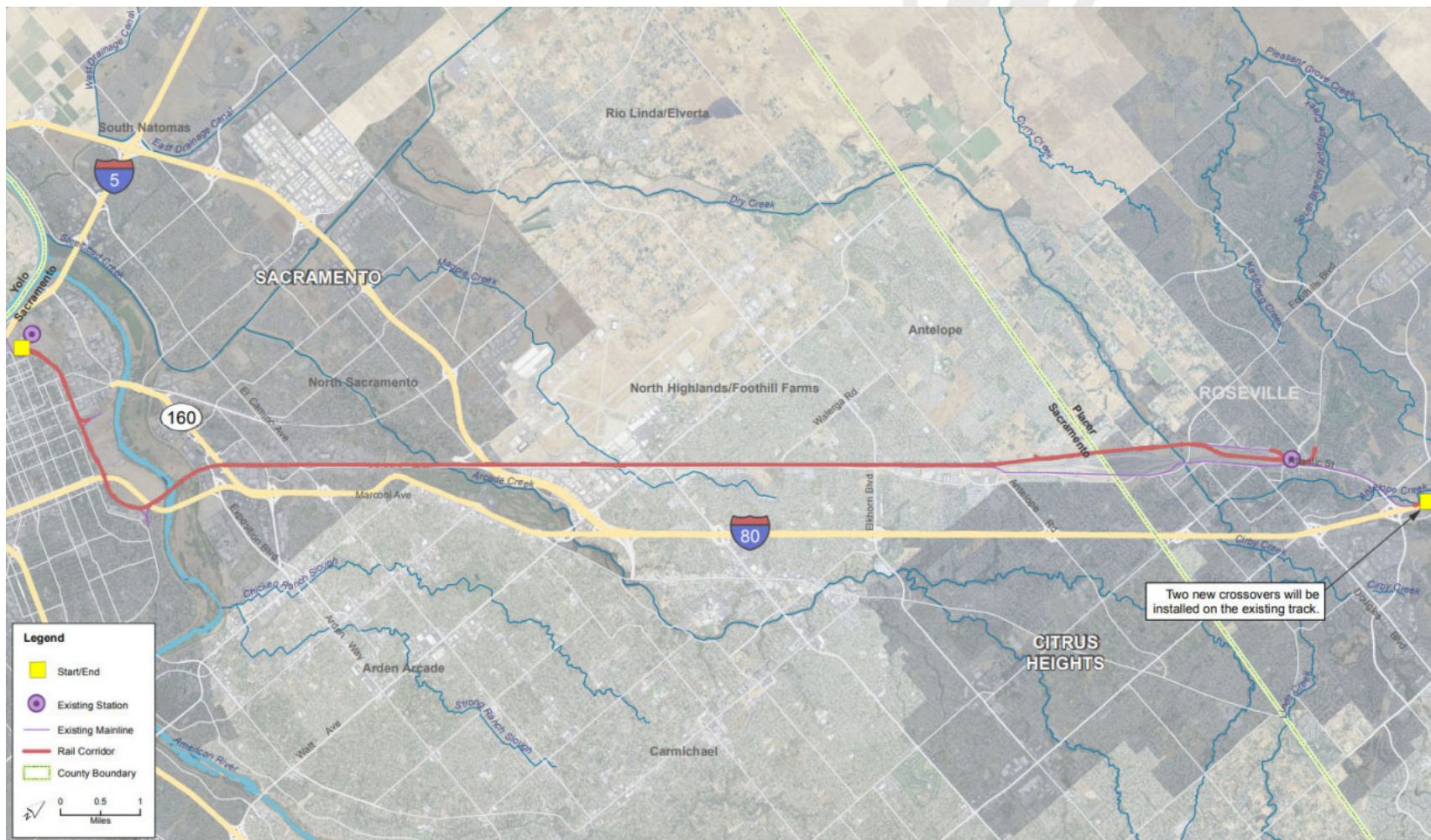
- Expand CCJPA service between Sacramento and Roseville (up to 10 trains daily)
